To join the WUC network and become a PRESIDIUUM, it is necessary to send a **letter of intent** to UNIBAS UNESCO Chair to present itself as a Coordination Group, illustrating briefly the job offer, motivation and objectives, also in relation to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development for sustainable development, the format of the Workshop and a first hypothesis of the title, the type of recipients of the Workshop (e.g.: university students).

Beyond this brief preliminary illustration, a more detailed **information sheet** will follow, as soon as it has been defined, useful for coordination and information sharing actions within the WUC Network:

- the composition of the coordination group;
- the contact manager;
- the classroom group (category, presumed number, ...);
- the title of the workshop to be realized as a presidium containing the object of the survey identified (the Mediterranean site / landscape);
- the program of the seminars to be carried out on site (at least in draft);
- the Workshop calendar (at least in draft: duration, period of execution and timing of the workshop);
- brief presentation of the Workshop, containing a brief illustration of the work cut, motivation and objectives, in relation to the 2030 Agenda for sustainable development (also identifying the SDGs to be associated with the Presidium Workshop);
- possible logo of the Presidium (this may be that of the institution to which the Presidium is responsible).
